The benefits of heightened self-awareness go beyond developing your cultural competence; they extend to many aspects of your life and will make it easier for you to engage with those having a different cultural background than yours.

Difficult Conversations: Giving and Receiving Feedback: Explore tools and skills to create a culture of feedback. Throughout the workshop, we will identify best practices for having feedback conversations.

Building Effective Teams: The key to successful teamwork lies in building a strong foundation that effectively supports team processes such as communication, conflict management, and decision making. This workshop will help you identify, develop, maintain critical social forces such as trust, cohesion, and leadership that support effective teamwork.

Leadership Bootcamp: This workshop will help new and experienced leaders continue their development through intense personal feedback and reflection allowing leaders to develop the skills and competencies critical to success for new and mid-level leadership.

Critical thinking for Leaders: This workshop will help you develop critical thinking skills to simplify and solve complex organizational problems. Critical thinking is a process and a leadership skill that can be improved over time through training and experience.
