Western Oregon University Office of General Counsel Outside Legal Expenses

The Western Oregon University (WOU) Office of General Counsel is staffed by two in-house attorneys who, in addition to legal services, perform additional administrative duties on behalf of the university (e.g., board secretary, faculty labor negotiations, workplace investigations). Each year, the WOU General Counsel engages outside counsel for legal services that either require specialized legal expertise (e.g., intellectual property, employer visa applications, compliance) or generally require more time than can be capably handled in-house among other responsibilities (e.g., litigation and complex transactions). The amount expended each typically varies based on the number, type, and nature of the legal matters arising during the course of given year.

For FY2021 (July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021), WOU's Office of General Counsel spent approximately \$5,711.30 on outside legal services, inclusive of all attorneys' fees, flings fees, and other costs associated with services rendered. The fees by matter type were expended as follows:
