

BS DEGREE IN ACCOUNTING

This form lists the requirements for completing a BS degree in Accounting. Students will need to complete university General Education requirements, complete the major requirements, and have the option to select a minor. If you are transferring from a community college, another university, or have previous college credits (including IB or AP), you may have already completed some of these requirements.

As you complete these classes, cross out the corresponding course to determine what you have left to graduate. If you complete 15 credit hours of required courses per term you could finish the 180 credit hours required to graduate in 4 years. If you complete more credit hours per term or attend Summer session, you would graduate sooner. If you complete less than 15 credits per term, the length of time it would take to graduate would be longer than 4 years.
