In Oregon, preliminary (initial) licensure candidates must complete a state-approved teacher performance assessment. Recently, Oregon has allowed locally constructed teacher performance assessments to be used in place of the nationally normed edTPA. Currently, Western is transitioning to more broad use of a locally-approved teacher performance assessment but the majority of candidate data below is from edTPA. All program completers MUST pass the appropriate teacher performance assessment so pass rates are 100% for all programs at the time of program completion.

However, Oregon began allowing EPP-designed TPAs developed and scored locally in 2022-2023 so some candidates, in this year, completed a locally-designed assessment. All completers, however, passed the required TPA as a condition of completion.
