### Catalog Description:

<u>MUEN103/303 UNIVERSITY BAND.</u> Rehearses and performs music of superior artistic quality but moderate technical demands. Presents a concert near the end of each term. No audition required. freshmen and Sophomores register for MUEN103. Juniors and Seniors register for MUEN303. Satisfies LACC requirements. May be repeated for credit.

### Course Goals and Objectives:

- 1. Non-music major students with moderate abilities and backgrounds in music will rehearse and perform artistically valid music with moderate or slight technical demands under the direction of University faculty.
- 2. Some music majors will participate in the course to develop skills on secondary instruments.
- 3. Undergraduate and graduate conducting students will conduct the group frequently.

## JUSTIFICATION FOR ADDING THE COURSE

This course would serve as both an LACC enrichment course and a laboratory for music majors in conducting and/or perfecting a secondary instrument. Increasing proficiency among Wind Ensemble players is narrowing the possibility of participation in that ensemble by players without an extensive background in music (including private study). Offering this course is in keeping with the liberal arts philosophy of the University and would correspond to similar course offered by virtually every major university in America.

Faculty and facilities needed: <u>Course to be taught by Dr. Nail or other qualified faculty in Room 108 in</u> <u>Smith Hall; a minimal number of specialty instruments may be needed, but WOU already owns</u> <u>most of those required.</u>

### Brief Course Outline:

Students will prepare and perform a concert of artistically valid music selected to match the strengths and weaknesses of the ensemble in any given semester.

Approval of this proposed catalogue change does not constitute a change from our current program. It merely creates a course designed to address the needs of a growing portion of our student body.

A number of our Bachelor of Music students are electing to become band or orchestra directors through earning a MAT. We do not currently offer these students a group of survey courses in techniques for specific families of instruments to assist them in preparing for careers as teachers (as is standard practice in virtually every university in America). In this course, students will learn basic playing and teaching techniques on percussion instruments as well as learning standard rehearsal practices and locating and evaluating a substantial amount of common source materials. The current University catalogue (2009/2010) lists only a woodwinds survey course for prospective teachers. This course will provide a significant advancement in preparing our students for successful careers in teaching and should be included as a natural component of our current program.

B) Describe the reasons for making this change.

To ensure that students preparing for a career in teaching have the necessary fundamental knowledge and experience to succeed;

To encourage students selecting careers in music other than teaching, such as composing or working in a recording studio, to gain a broader knowledge of all instruments;

C) How and when will the effectiveness of these changes be determined?

The effectiveness of these changes will be determined primarily through the demonstrated readiness and effectiveness of our students as they attempt to qualify for licensure in teaching or enter the professional world. A rigorous barrier examination for prospective band and orchestra directors has been established; successful completion of this course and others like it in the other instrumental families constitutes Music Department approval for entry into the MAT program. This course may be challenged for credit by students who already have an extensive background in woodwind performance and technique.
