	OIED Report on 3x1 and 2x2 International Student Programs	Ernie Buncal	Neng emailed templates and information regarding contracts with WOU divisions and other country's universities; including pre-requisites, course work and degree program requirements. This information is also online. Some international students must first attend language proficiency classes, before attending WOU university classes. This could delay their graduation time. The point is, even though the program is called 3x1 or 2x2, there is some flexibility for the student to complete all the requirements in more than just 1 or 2 years. Members still expressed concerns about fitting the international students in to the upper division classes, especially if they get full. The IESC still requests that OIED notify the divisions/departments of the number of international students expected each year and quarter.
