RE: Bylaw addition and election of Faculty Senate Executive Committee Curriculum System Programmer.

The Faculty Senate Executive Committee proposes a new Faculty Senate Executive Committee position: Faculty Curriculum System Manger/Programmer. We propose this position as a formal role for the Faculty Curriculum System Manger/Programmer and give this faculty member an ex officio spot on the Faculty Senate Executive Committee to enhance communication. As course and program goals and learning outcomes are integrated into the faculty curriculum proposal system, we feel that Faculty Senate should retain oversight of this aspect of the curriculum proposal process. We are currently working with the current curriculum system programmer, Camila Gabaldon, to assure the archiving of course and program goals and learning outcomes integrates seamlessly into the faculty curriculum system with oversight for course and program goals and learning outcomes remaining within the relevant faculty departments and divisions.

The proposed bylaw changes are highlighted.

 the skills and desire, they are responsible for making adjustments or changes directly to the
 curriculum system. In this case their title is "Executive Committee Curriculum System
 Manager/Programmer. If not, they will be responsible for working directly with the individual(s)
 making those changes to implement them with as little disruption as possible. In this case their
 title is "Executive Committee Curriculum System Manager"
- Serve as a resource and primary contact for questions about or issues with the curriculum system.
- Attend Faculty Senate Executive Committee meetings as needed.
