Completing the hiring paperwork in a timely manner will ensure you gain your employee email and your WOU Faculty Portal, where you can access Moodle (learning management system), WolfWeb (WOU's employee and student system) and other resources, including exploring and enrolling in benefits through <u>PEBB</u> (Public Employees Benefit Board). You will use the PEBB link in your portal to annually re-enroll in benefits during open enrollment every October. WolfWeb, which manages class enrollment and employee information, allows you to purchase passes to our state of the art <u>Health and Wellness Center</u> as well as parking passes, should you choose to commute to campus. Faculty contracts begin on September 16 and classes begin on September 30 this year. There are a variety of professional development and other University events scheduled during that
