2. Calls for Service

There are a number of open service opportunities for faculty. We need faculty representatives on these committees:

UBAC: The University Budget Advisory Committee (UBAC) is an advisory group consisting of representation from faculty, classified staff, unclassified exempt staff, students and administrators. Committee members are expected to represent their constituencies while applying a university wide perspective to the budget deliberations and recommendations.

- One faculty seat
- Two-year term of service
- Meeting frequency: twice per month (or as needed); 2 hour meetings

University Council: The University Council is responsible for determining the degree to which the university is meeting its mission and is engaged in comprehensive, ongoing, systematic assessment of its work that leads to mission fulfillment and continuous improvement.

- One faculty seat
- Two-year term of service
- Meeting frequency: Friday mornings, twice per term; 2 hour meetings

Final Exam WorkGroup: Some faculty have expressed concern over missing days/times from the final exam schedule; since this schedule was created by faculty senate, we need a small workgroup if we are going to revise it to include those times.

- 4-5 faculty
- Fall term (continue into winter only if necessary)
- Meets as needed

Reminder: asynchronous online = no rigid final exam time allowed

synchronous online = use final exam schedule to set specific exam time
