

## Provost Winningham's Faculty Senate Report March 9, 2021

1. Fall term planning. Schedules will be sent to divisions to confirm course delivery modality in late April and will due back during the first week of May. This will give faculty more time to assess the best course delivery modalities for fall term, hopefully with more information about community health conditions. A faculty survey will go out in late March to identify trends, faculty perceptions and ideas to support the safety of our campus community. Fall term priority registration will begin on May 10 and regular registration will begin on May 17.

We are still working with our state partners to get updated guidance on classroom capacities for fall term.

2. Fall term scheduling. The initial submissions of the fall term schedules using the course scheduling and FTE parameters was successful. Almost all programs submitted schedules within the allotted FTE. We now have almost all of the course releases assigned at the program level. The Faculty Development Committee will be awarding course releases next quarter but they have already voted to move the 21-22 course release decision making process up so those decisions will be known before the initial schedule is submitted February 2022 for 22-23 academic year.
