

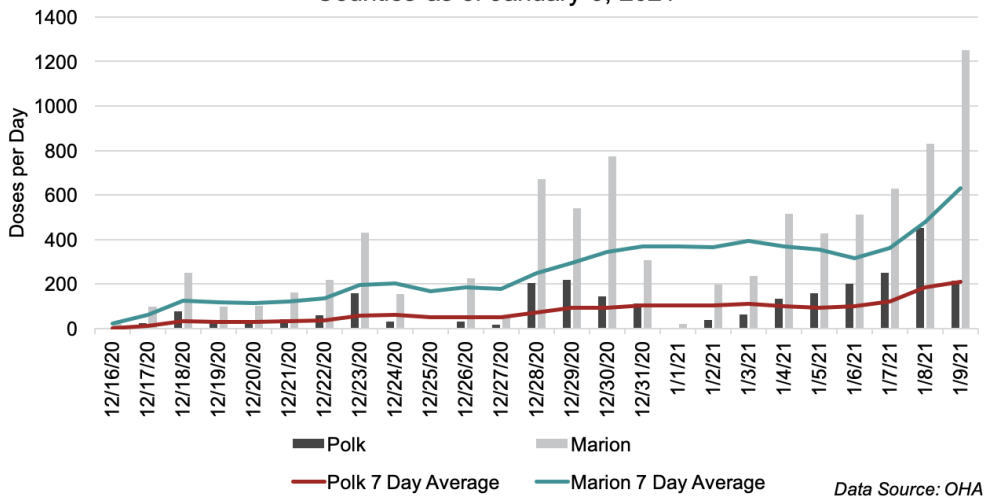

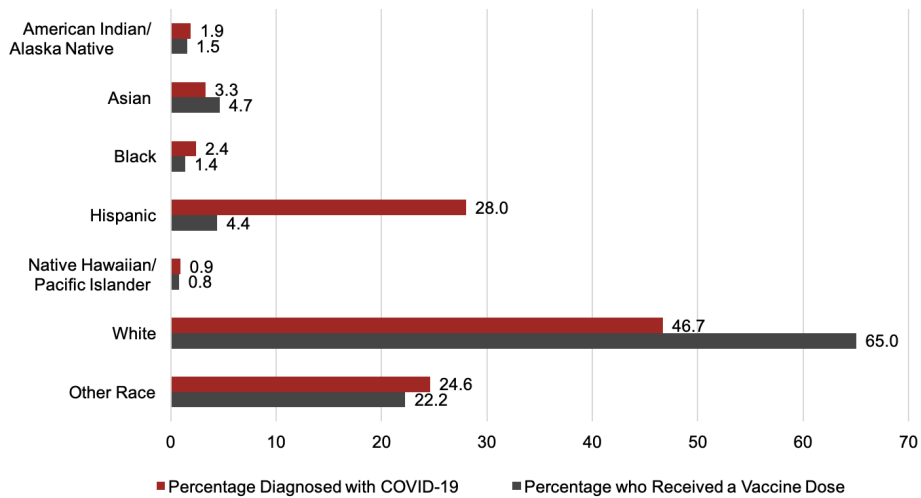
Daily Doses of COVID-19 Vaccines Administered in Polk & Marion Counties as of January 9, 2021



### By the Numbers (1/11/21):

- 25,480,725** ...vaccine doses distributed to US states and territories
- 8,987,322** ...vaccine doses administered in US states and territories
- 12,000**...Governor Brown's goal of daily vaccine doses administered in Oregon by 1/15
- 6,359**...average daily vaccine doses administered in Oregon from 1/3-1/9
- 2,609**...individuals in Polk County given a vaccine dose
- 3.1**...percentage of Polk County residents given a vaccine dose
- 2.3**...percentage of Oregonians given a vaccine dose

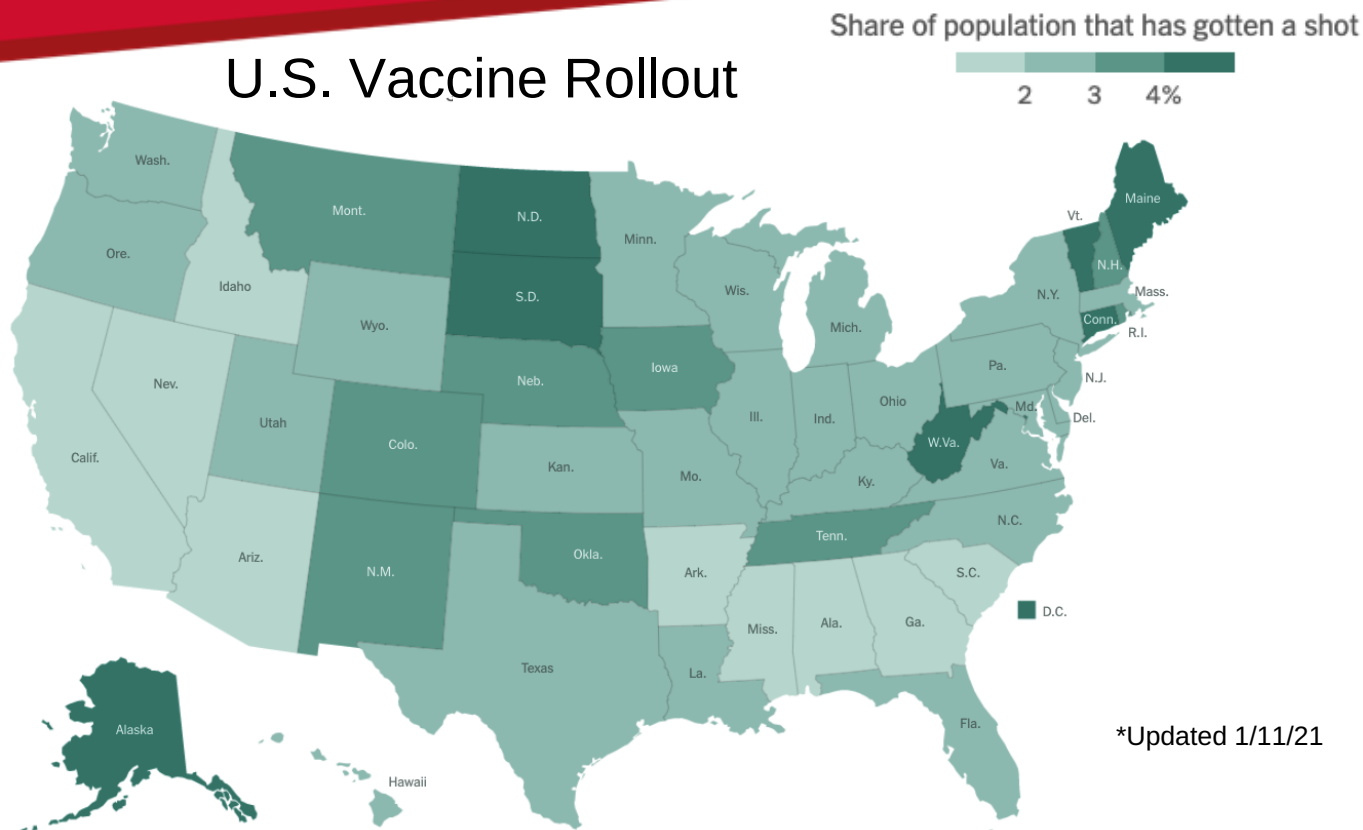

### Vaccine Update

In its recent [Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report](#), the CDC presented data on adverse reactions associated with the initial doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine, administered December 14-23. The Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System detected 21 cases of anaphylaxis (severe allergic reaction) after 1,893,360 doses, a rate of 11.1 cases per one million doses. All 21 individuals with anaphylaxis were treated and released.

### International Good News

Israel, which has inoculated a higher proportion of its population against the coronavirus than any other country, is delivering shots so quickly that it is outstripping its supply of vaccine. Health officials, scrambling to buy more doses may pause giving the first round of shots to younger citizens to deliver the second, final injections to the elderly. Israel has reached over 20 percent of its residents with the initial dose. Since rolling out the campaign on Dec. 20, Israel has repeatedly surpassed its goal of 150,000 vaccinations a day.
