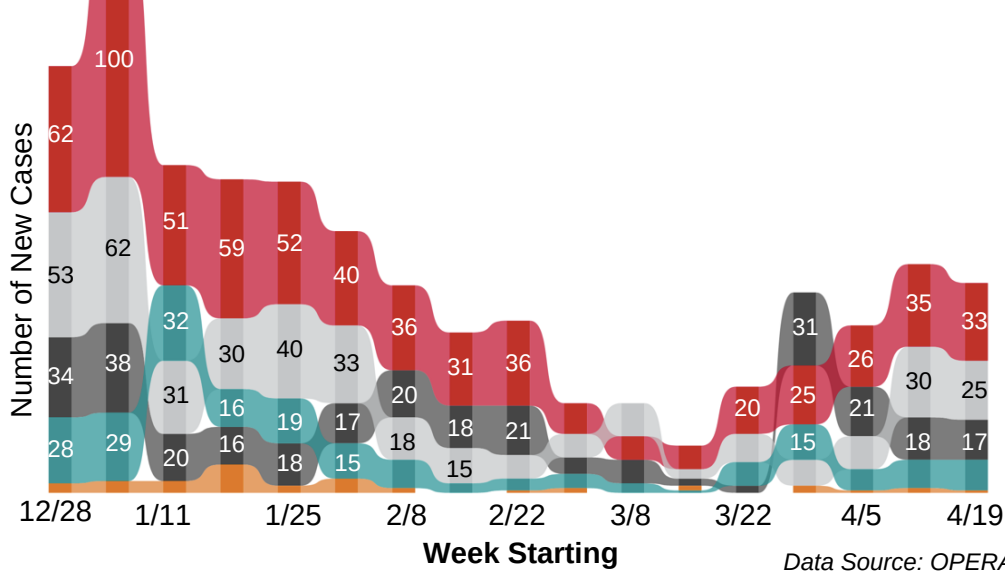

### Polk County Main Takeaways:

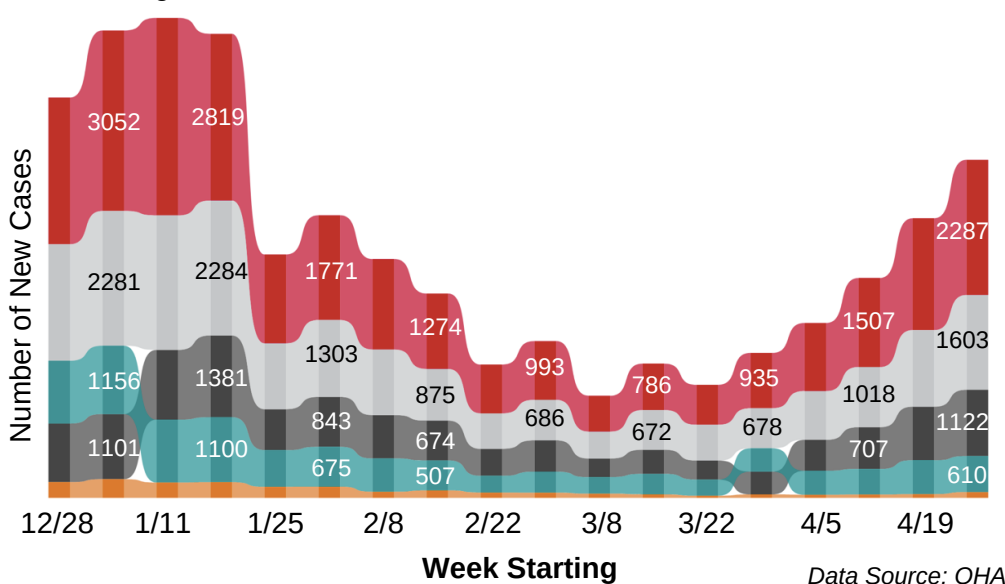
- The 20-39 age group has led with the majority of cases through most of this year.
- Case numbers in the 80+ age group have stayed consistently low.
- On April 30th, Polk County returned to the Extreme Risk Category.

### Oregon Main Takeaways:

- The 20-39 age group has led with the majority of cases this year.
- Case numbers in the 80+ age group have stayed consistently low.
- Individuals ages 40-59 represent the second-highest overall number of cases.
- Similar to Polk County, cases peaked in early January and decreased through February, but have started increasing since late March.

COVID-19 Cases by Age Group in Oregon

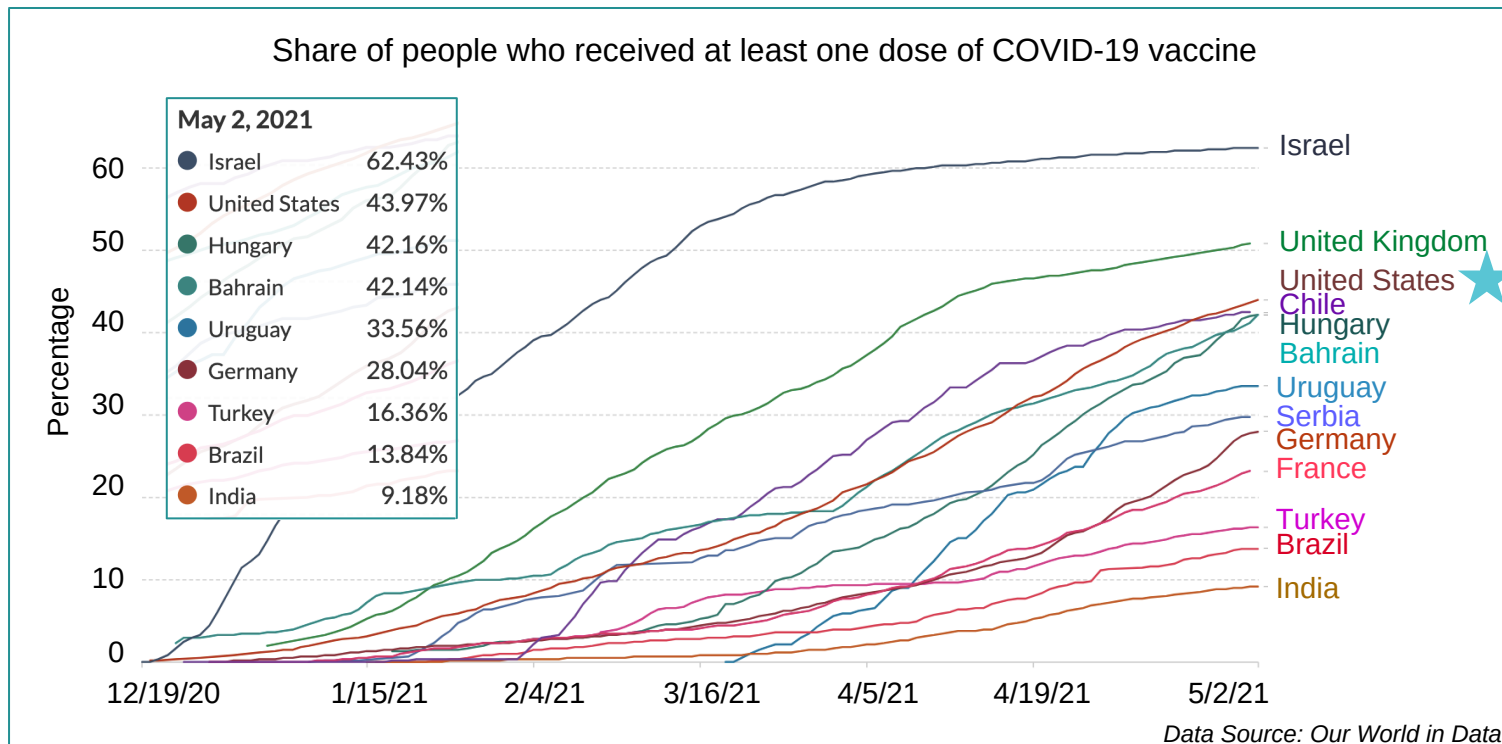
Age of Case ● 0-19 ● 20-39 ● 40-59 ● 60-79 ● 80+

### Polk County Vaccine Update:

- Everyone ages 16+ in Oregon is eligible for vaccination.
- 43% of Polk County's population have received at least one dose, ranking us 11th in Oregon.
- 73% of individuals in Polk County ages 65+ are fully vaccinated.
- Appointments are no longer needed at the WOU clinic!
