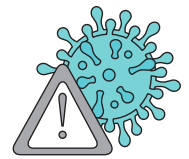




I'm a **WOU Employee**. I've Tested Positive for Covid-19 - What Do I Do?



Here's what you do now...

Updated 1.27.2022

Isolate

Stay home for **at least 5 days** after your symptoms began, or after you tested positive if you don't have symptoms.

After 5 days you can safely end isolation if:

- you had **no fever** (without using fever-reducing medications) in the previous 24 hours; **and**
- your symptoms have significantly improved

Continue to wear a mask around others for +5 days.

Inform Your Supervisor and HR

Inform your supervisor and Human Resources about your positive test results.

Notify Your Close Contacts

Call or email everyone you were in close contact* with when you were contagious** and inform them of their exposure.

**You are contagious 48 hours before your symptoms began, or before you got tested if you have no symptoms.



Isolation means staying away from anyone in your house, if you live with other people, by staying in a separate room and using a different bathroom.

***What's exposure?** Being within 6 feet of a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19 for at least 15 minutes over a 24 hour period, even with masks.
