For Graduate Students

ACCEPT OR DECLINE FINANCIAL AID OFFER. Log into your WOU Portal and click the green dollar sign icon to access your financial aid. Click on "Menu" to see the following tabs:

Authorization to Pay Charges	READ Make a selectionwe recommend "Yes"
Accept Awards	READ Check the "I Agree" box and click "Submit" Change status of awards from "Pending" to either "Accept" or "Decline" Reduce loan amounts if desired Click "Submit"
Awards	View your financial aid package
Documents	View any outstanding documents that might prevent disbursement Follow hyperlinks to resolve outstanding documents
Messages	View IMPORTANT messages regarding your eligibility or further steps you must take to ensure your aid disburses
Loan History	A summary of your total Federal Direct Loan borrowing as of your most recent FAFSA submission

TELL US VIA EMAIL--<u>finaid@wou.edu</u>--IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND LESS THAN FULL TIME. We've awarded you aid with the assumption that you will take at least 9 credits per term. You can still receive most items of financial aid even if you aren't a full time student, but you must tell us if you're less than full time before your aid will disburse.

BORROWING AN UNSUBSIDIZED STUDENT LOAN FOR THE FIRST TIME?

Click on "Complete Entrance Counseling"

Click on "Complete Loan Agreement for a Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loan (MPN)"

BORROWING A GRADUATE PLUS LOAN? This is a credit-based loan that you must apply for.

Click on "Graduate/Professional Students" Tab

Click on "Apply for a PLUS Loan" link
