PELL PLUS Scholarship Program

The newest scholarship program at WOU, Pell Plus, helps incoming Oregon high school graduates cover the remaining standard tuition and mandatory fees after financial aid has been applied.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- · Current Oregon resident
- 2021 Oregon high school graduate
- Admissible to WOU as a first-year freshman for fall term 2022
- Have a 3.4 cumulative unweighted high school GPA
- Eligible to receive a federal Pell grant as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 credits per term at WOU. The program will cover a maximum of 15 credits per term.
- The scholarship is renewable for 12 consecutive terms if a student remains eligible for the federal Pell grant, enrolls in 12 to 15 credits per term, and maintains a minimum 2.00 GPA.

COVERED COSTS

If you qualify, you must apply for federal and state grants. The program covers remaining standard tuition and fees after financial aid is applied for a maximum of 15 credits per term. Student loans may be used for paying additional charges.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

- Submit the FAFSA beginning Oct. 1 and no later than Feb. 1
 - WOU FAFSA school code: 003209
 - Accept all state and federal grants awarded
- Apply for admission as early as possible and no later than May 1.
 WOU's admission requirements are available at wou.edu/admission.
- Submit your final high school transcript by Aug. 1
