#### First Year Seminar proposal workshops

First Year Seminars are a new feature of the General Education Program. These courses are topical/integrative seminars designed to incorporate the development of a subset of foundational skills (reading, information literacy, creative and critical thinking, technological literacy, and either writing or quantitative literacy) into topical coursework. FYS sections are capped at 25, and with over 850 incoming freshmen each needing to take two seminars, we are planning to offer 72 sections in 2019-20. All faculty and staff interested in participating in First Year Seminars are invited to submit a proposal.

There will be many opportunities to participate in a short workshop to gain assistance with preparing FYS proposals throughout Fall term. During these workshops, you can expect to learn a bit more about the expectations for FYS courses and gain some strategies for topic selection and planning to help engage students in the foundational skills to be featured in all FYS sections. This online course is intended as a supplement to the workshop and includes a variety of resources for successful proposal and course development.
