- 1. The Honors Program offers a challenging alternative to WOU's Liberal Arts Core Curriculum (LACC).
- 2. The Honors LACC is at least three fewer classes than the non-Honors LACC.
- 3. Freshmen and sophomore Honors students share numerous courses together, building long-lasting friendships and collegiality.
- 4. Honors students have guaranteed enrollment in their Honors Classes.
- 5. Special scholarships are available exclusively to students in the Honors Program.
- 6. All Honors courses have 25 or fewer students compared to 45-100 students in their non-Honors counterparts.
- 7. The Honors LACC is compatible, and not in competition, with every major field of study.
- 8. Honors courses feature exciting off-campus trips including seeing a musical performance as well as plays at the Oregon Shakespeare Festival.
- 9. Housing in the all-Honors wing of Ackerman dormitory is available but not required.
- 10. Nothing is lost by enrolling in Honors classes--if you choose to drop the program, your Honors classes will count towards your non-Honors LACC requirements.
