WANT TO EAT ON CAMPUS? Interested in saving a little money when you do?

Campus Dining invites any member of the Western Oregon community to apply for a Wolf Bonus Account (WBA). The WBA is a great way for individuals to eat meals while on campus and provides a 5% enrichment with each purchase. An account can be opened in the Campus Dining office located in the South Sister Annex (lower floor, under Valsetz Dining Hall) with a minimum deposit of twenty dollars. (Exact cash, check, credit or debit cards are all accepted).

For your convenience, your WOU ID Card is encoded with the wolf bonus account information and can then be used just like a debit card to make food purchases. Your WBA card is accepted at all campus dining locations including the Valsetz Dining Hall, restaurants in the Werner University Center, and The Press, located in the Hamersly Library. After each purchase, your remaining balance is displayed on the cashier screen. You can ask for your balance, or ask the cashier to print a receipt that will display your balance. The cashier can also do a balance inquiry at any time, no purchase necessary.

Treat your WOU I.D. card like a credit card and report lost cards promptly to a Valsetz cashier.

- The account will be changed so the lost card will no longer work.
- You may either have a temporary voucher made up and a \$2.00 charge will be applied to your WOU account. Your temporary voucher will serve as your meal card for up to 5 working days.
- Or you can elect to have a new card made. Requests for new student ID cards should be made in the Werner University Center. A \$15.00 fee for the new card is due at the time the card is made for you.

OPENING AN ACCOUNT

To open an account, fill out the form in this document; take or mail directly with your minimum \$20.00 deposit to the Campus Dining office. If you submit your application in person, your WOU ID card will be encoded there and serve as your meal card. Alternatively, if you choose to submit your application by mail, you will need to have your WOU ID card encoded at the Campus Dining Office, University Housing Office or at the Health and Wellness Center.

Additional deposits can be made by phone with a credit card, with cash, or check at the Campus Dining office.

- The Campus Dining office is located in the South Sister Annex, on the ground floor of the Valsetz Dining Complex, and is open Monday Friday, 8 am 4 pm.
- The University Housing office is located on the ground floor of Ackerman Hall.
- The Health and Wellness Center is located south of the DeVolder Family Science Center.
