Housing

Summer students will live in the Arbor Park complex. Arbor Park, opened in Fall 2002, is an apartment complex which houses 210 students on the north end of campus. Each apartment has four private bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and living room all shared by up to four people. Due to COVID-19, we may be only assigning 2 students per apartment [subject to change]. Each bedroom is furnished with a bed and extra-long (36" x 80") mattress, desk, desk chair, bookcase, dresser drawers, and a closet. The living room is furnished with a couch, two overstuffed chairs, an end table, and a coffee table. The kitchen includes an eating bar with four stools, a refrigerator, range, and dishwasher. Each bedroom has internet access.

All residential and dining buildings at Western Oregon University are designated as non-smoking facilities.

Plan to bring your own bedding, personal items, kitchen utensils/dishes/cookware, and general cleaning supplies. Microwaves are not furnished. You may bring a mini-microwave up to 900 watts.

MOVE-IN DAY:

You will receive an email with check-in instructions before moving in. Please notify the housing office by email (housing@wou.edu) if you will be a late arrival (after 5pm or after your Move-in date). Rates will not be pro-rated for late arrivals nor early checkouts.

HOUSING CONTRACT: When you sign the 2020 Summer Housing Contract you are entering into a legally binding agreement that begins the day you move in. It includes specific dates and possible extra fees. CANCELLATIONS: Please notify the housing office by email (housing@wou.edu) if you want to cancel your summer housing reservation before you arrive. Meals

Meal Plans are not available for Summer Housing. Your assigned apartment has a full-sized kitchen for your use, so please bring dishes and cookware. Please see the campus dining webpage (<http://www.wou.edu/housing/campus-dining/>) for more summer dining options and hours.

Optional Wolf Bonus Account

The optional **Wolf Bonus Account** (WBA) is accepted at all campus dining facilities. Your WOU ID card would be used just like a debit card in all campus dining locations and gives you a 5% enhancement with each purchase. You may open a WBA with a deposit of \$20 or more. You may add more money to your WBA anytime (\$20 minimum) in the housing office (Monday – Friday, 9am-12pm & 1pm- 5pm). You may ask the cashier for your account balance anytime or to print you a receipt that shows your current purchase and account balance.
