2020 Summer Stayover Program

Are you undecided where you'll be living for the summer?

Whether you are working, going to summer school, or just hanging out, the Summer Stayover Program may be for you!

Eligibility:

- Currently living on campus now or were living on campus Winter 2020.
- Signed up to live on campus Fall term
- Summer classes not required

Summer Stayover students will live in Arbor Park. Typically, we assign 4 students per apartment, but due to COVID-19 we may be only assigning 2 students per apartment [subject to change]. Most of Arbor Park will be closed for cleaning, repairs, and conferences; therefore, stayover students will live together as a community in one area rather than in their individual 2020-2021 room assignments.

The Process:

- reserved a spot for 2020-2021 during Housing Renewal room selection process
- complete the Room Condition Report for your current spring room (if you are currently living on campus)
- stay in your current room until your assigned summer apartment is ready
- make/keep your current spring room ready for custodial services
- check into your summer room (tentatively June 16) with RSC staff
- move your stuff to Arbor Park (tentatively June 16)
- turn in your old spring room keys to RSC Staff
- keep your same RSC mailbox
- pay your summer rent monthly (through your Wolf Web account)
- Check-out of your Arbor Park room & Check-in to your Fall Room with RSC staff (tentatively September 2)
- **make prior arrangements with housing staff if you will be away during any of the scheduled moving days**

Meals: Your assigned apartment has a full-sized kitchen for your use. Bring your own dishes and cookware. Please see the campus dining webpage (<http://www.wou.edu/housing/campus-dining>) for more summer dining options.

Optional Wolf Bonus Account

The **Wolf Bonus Account** (WBA) is accepted at all campus dining facilities. Your WOU ID card is used just like a debit card in all campus dining locations and gives you a 5% enhancement with each purchase. You may open a WBA with a deposit of \$20 or more. You may add more money to your WBA anytime (\$20 minimum) in the housing office. You may ask the cashier for your account balance anytime or to print you a receipt that shows your current purchase and account balance. Rates: The rate for the summer is **\$2,376 per person** (\$24/day for 14 weeks).

- includes all utilities and campus network access
- your Wolf Web account will be billed and due incrementally each month
- **\$432 due June 13** (or as soon as it shows in your Wolf Web account)
- **\$744 due July 1**
- **\$744 due August 1**
- **\$456 due September 1**
