Housing

Summer students will live together in the Arbor Park Apartments. Arbor Park, opened in Fall 2002, it is an apartment complex which houses 210 students on the north end of campus. Spruce, Noble, and Cedar Halls make up Arbor Park. There are 5-6 apartments per floor. Each apartment has four private bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and living room all shared by up to four people. Each bedroom is furnished with a bed and extra-long (36" x 80") twin mattress, desk, desk chair, bookcase, dresser drawers, and a closet. The living room is furnished with a couch, two overstuffed chairs, an end table, and a coffee table. The kitchen includes an eating bar with four stools, a refrigerator, range, and dishwasher. Each bedroom has internet access.

Plan to bring your own bedding, personal items, kitchen utensils/dishes/cookware, and general cleaning supplies. Microwaves are not included. You may bring a mini-microwave up to 900 watts.

MOVE-IN DAY:

You will receive an email with check-in instructions before moving in. Please notify the housing office by email (housing@wou.edu) if you will be a late arrival (after 5pm or after your Move-in date). Rates will not be pro-rated for late arrivals nor early checkouts.

HOUSING CONTRACT: When you sign the 2021 Summer Housing Contract you are entering into a legally binding agreement that begins the day you move in. It includes specific dates and possible extra fees.
