Department / Job Summary:

This position is in the Wolfstore (bookstore) at Western Oregon University in Monmouth. Wolfstore is Western Oregon University's campus store, and provides convenient, high-quality, and competitively-priced products and services in support of the mission of the university, either directly or indirectly to students, faculty, staff, and guests. wolfstore.wou.edu

This is a regular, 12-month, full-time position and is represented by the Service Employees International Union/Oregon Public Employees Union (SEIU). The Head Cashier/Website Specialist provides and models customer service and security throughout the store; routes incoming mail and telephone calls through the customer service area; processes MBS sales, returns, rental transactions, and textbook buybacks through the point-of-sale system; maintains eCommerce website and online and social media presence; schedules student employees under given parameters; trains and leads student employees; and schedules and trains temporary employees.

We are not considering candidates who require Visa sponsorship support. Additionally, the university typically only considers visa support for employees placed in specialized positions that are continuing regular university appointments.

Working Conditions:

This position involves high public contact and may be stressful at times. The store may range from very busy to very slow several times per day. At the beginning of each term, the store is extremely busy. Daily computer research and data entry are involved. Sitting and standing for periods of time are required. Some work may be performed in a large, windowless warehouse.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum of 2 years of retail cashier experience which includes exchanging money for purchases and making change.
- Minimum of 2 years customer service experience.
- The ability to train new employees
- Computer skills, keyboarding, and ten-key adding machine
