Position Summary:

The **Cook 1** position provides skilled labor and skilled cooking/production for Dining Service and support for WOU Services and is responsible for menu items prepared "made to order"; clean up, set-up and stocking of the areas as needed. The Cook 1 also monitors students in all areas of Service and Production to ensure standardized recipes, and ensures that sanitary production and serving methods are followed at all service locations. The Cook 1 helps train lower class and students in production and areas needed. The Cook 1 position must be flexible as the schedule is irregular and dependent on business needs. Interruption of work -Academic break or in circumstances lack of business.

Minimum Requirements:

- Minimum 2 years cooking experience required.
- Ability to supervise and train others in Grill production duties including maintaining food quality and sanitation standards.
- Must be able to read, write and calculate simple math problems.
- Knowledge of dry and liquid measuring units used in recipes.
- Must be able to understand and follow standardized recipes.
- Ability to act as a lead worker over student workers, to work harmoniously with co-workers and be able to meet daily meal time demands.
