Position Summary:

The Custodian position supports the mission of the university by maintaining the cleanliness and general appearances of the buildings on campus. The person in this role will be responsible for maintaining and cleaning equipment and making minor repairs and adjustments as needed. They will also contribute to energy savings by turning off lights as needed and making sure buildings are secure and doors closed.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must be able to work the night shift {9pm-5:30am} along with occasional overtime.
- Must be able to speak and understand basic English to understand instructions, report hazards, read chemicals and MSDS sheets and work safely in the buildings.
- Must be able to work around cleaning chemicals and exposure to bloodborne pathogens
- Physical labor including lifting, bending, stooping, reaching, climbing ladders, and manipulating custodial tools and instruments with repetition.

Women, Black, Indigenous and People of Color, veterans, people who identify as LGBTQ+, and people with disabilities are highly encouraged to apply for this position, even if they do not meet qualifications exactly as listed. We are most interested in finding the best person to fulfill this role within our university community, and that candidate may be someone with transferable skills and experience rather than exact qualifications.
