PROGRAM NOTES: The Focus area in the major is determined with the help of an advisor. Focus areas include at least five (5) courses total in each of the two areas; at least four (4) of the five courses must be upper-division courses, for a minimum of 12 credits upper-division per block/area; other Humanities areas may be included in the plan, in addition to the two blocks of courses. First-year language courses will not count in the major.
