 - i. Areas budgets.
- Why new soccer team if WOU is struggling for money? Money was an issue back in 2019 with the in person IFC meetings. How much money is athletics bringing into the school, historically at schools football and volleyball are the two highest grossing sports. What are their numbers for the school?  - i. Randi: Enrollment decreasing, we have been asked why we do not have men's soccer. Interim President Kenton thinks it would be a great addition for students and bring more students to campus. Student athletes still pay for IFC fees, tuition, housing. None of our sports are revenue producing. DII does not make a profit. Brings spirit to campus life. Bring diversity on campus and is critical.
