Obtaining an Oregon State Driver's License

It is important to note that you will get a limited term license as you are only temporarily in the United States. A limited term licenses expires on the same date as your authorized length of stay.

What do I need to get an Oregon driver's license?

- Study the Oregon Driver Manual;
- Fill out the application;
- Take it to a DMV office;
- Show proof of your residence address and legal presence/identity
 - o Unexpired foreign passport with a current admittance stamp and I-94 with the actual date in the "Admit Until" field.
 - A bill or other "official" document showing your current address of residence. If you do
 not have any documents that would verify your physical address, please request a letter of
 Address Verification from the Office of International Education and Development.
- Pass a vision test:
- Optional take the <u>practice knowledge test;</u>
- Pass the knowledge test;
 - o There is a \$5 fee each time that you take the test. The test is available in English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Russian and Vietnamese.
 - Online testing available.
- Optional Get Driver Training or get an instruction permit;
- Call to schedule a drive test;
- Pass the drive test with DMV;
 - o There is a \$9 fee each time that you take the driver's test. Only you and the examiner are allowed in the vehicle.
 - You must provide a passenger vehicle with a valid registration that is in proper working order.
 - O You must show proof of insurance.
- Pass the drive test with a class C testing business;
 - o Provide drive tests approved by DMV.
 - o Set their own fees and days of operation.
 - o Test only for Class C non-commercial license applicants.
- Pay the <u>fees that apply</u>; and
- Get your picture taken.
 - o **Photo Rules** These items are **not** allowed in a photo:
 - Eyeglasses;
 - Sunglasses;
 - o Hat or head covering (other than religious);
 - Contacts that change the appearance of the eye;
 - Face paint;
 - o Stickers or bandages; or
 - o Anything that covers your face or changes your appearance.
