

## Online Course Physical Presence Verification Form

According to U.S. government regulations, international undergraduate students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credits and graduate students a minimum of 9 credits. Furthermore, the regulations state that <u>no more than 3 credits of online or distance education coursework may count towards the "full course of study" requirement - e.g. If registered for only 12 credits, no more than 3 can be online, in other words undergraduate students must register for at least 9 in class credits and graduate students for at least 6 in class credits each term.</u>

## 8 C.F.R. § 214.2(f)(6)(i)(G) states:

For F-1 students enrolled in classes for credit or classroom hours, no more than the equivalent of one class or three credits per session, term, semester, trimester, or quarter may be counted if taken on-line or through distance education in a course that does not require the <u>student's physical attendance for classes</u>, <u>examination or other purposes integral to completion of the class</u>.

International students who are enrolled in more than 3 credits of online or distance courses as part of their full course of study are required to document that they have made arrangements with their course instructor to ensure physical attendance in order to maintain their immigration status.
