As you know, the General Education Committee is in the process of building course offerings for WOU's new General Education program. Beginning in 2019-20, we aim to offer a path through General Education in Salem. In effect, in 2019-20, that means we seek:

- \rightarrow Two first-year seminars, one focused on Writing and the other on Quantitative Literacy
- \rightarrow WR 121 and WR 122
- ightarrow MTH 105 or MTH 243
- \rightarrow One Critical Thinking course
- \rightarrow One Communication course
- \rightarrow One Health Promotion course
- → Two Exploring Knowledge: Literary & Aesthetic Perspectives
- → Two Exploring Knowledge: Social, Historical and Civic Perspectives

The Salem site does not have science lab facilities, so students will be advised to pursue dual enrollment with Chemeketa Community College to complete Saturday lab science courses or to take a lab science course in Monmouth if their schedules accommodate this.

We will offer integrating knowledge courses in Salem beginning in 2020-21.
