An individual was pouring liquid from a large stock pot when they stopped due to feeling a sharp pain in their back, causing them to leave work early and seek medical attention from their physician who has treated them for past back injuries/strains.	 In a hurry. Prior back injuries. Failure to ask for assistance. Carrying/transporting and pouring large saucepot holding 5 to 8 gallons of liquid/sauce. Approximate weight of 40 pounds. 	 Ask for assistance when carrying, lifting, and pouring heavy items.
An individual was attempting to push a full dumpster when the front wheel rolled up on to his left foot 2 nd toe and then rolled back off causing severe pain. The individual advised they thought their toe may be broken, but did not seek medical attention.	 Moving full 3-yard portable wheeled dumpster alone, weighing several hundred pounds. Wearing tennis shoes with mesh tops. No medical treatment sought at time of report. 	 Be sure to ask for assistance with full dumpsters. Be aware of surroundings. Keep feet clear of wheels.
