- Update on Status of our 2020/21 Goals
 - Communication
 - With the creation of the department presentations we have made it easy for departments to communicate with employees besides just emails.
 - There has been more communication from the Board of Trustees (B of T) since the last special meeting. A website is being created for the B of T to share communications with students, staff and faculty. A focus of the website will be the transparency of the new President search.
 - Evaluations
 - There is behind the scenes work with Human Resources to amp up the evaluation process so that it is more meaningful. This would be closer to looking like a 360 evaluation rather than the current evaluation system.
 - Right now there is nothing tangible happening for evaluations but conversations are being had that have not happened in the past. And Colin let those involved know that they can reach out to the Staff Senate since we have had evaluations as a focus for the past couple of years.
 - Many of the Staff Senate member's departments have seen improvements in evaluations being completed in a timely manner.
 - Currently there is no evaluation training for supervisors which can cause challenges. Training for supervisors can provide a better understanding of what evaluations are and how they can best be conducted.
