- We received an email from a campus member expressing their concerns with the cost of permits. Open for conversation about how/if we want to proceed with this concern.
- Essentially the parking review committee was told in May 2023 that the fees would be increased and despite concerns by several committee members there was no voting process. The committee had zero say about the cost of the increases and the decision to increase was made pretty unilaterally by Ana Karaman and Rebecca Chiles.
- Recommendation was made to have the parking review committee send Adrian a list of their concerns that they brought up would be great. Then staff senate can look into the process a bit more and report back to the group.
- Remote Work/Return to Campus Policy
 - We received an email from a campus member expressing their concerns with the return to campus update.
 - It seems that there is not a lot of consistency across campus about what the
 expectations will be. Some departments have been given pretty clear guidelines while
 others have not.
 - It would have been great to have a more open discussion about this with the campus as a whole and allow folks on campus to provide their feedback and/or suggestions. Not allowing folks that are impacted by this a voice in the process only furthers the frustration.
