

2-6-23 WUC Advisory Committee minutes

Called to Order at 2:03pm.

Reports

- Werner University Center
 - People Counter Information was provided based on the last 5 or 6 years. Copy of that is at the bottom of these minutes. There are upward trends, but definitely not at the levels prior to Covid.
 - Several projects have been completed this year. Abby's House heating and cooling upgrade (10 plus years in the making), Carpet replacement that will set us at a good place for not having to do routine carpet replacement for 3 to 4 years, ADA door opener installed for the Computer lab (bucket list item for Chelsea for the last decade) and the ADA door opener unit that is housed within the Pacific room was upgraded to be much quieter. That way when the unit is activated for use in the west lobby, it won't impact events happening in the Pacific room as the old unit would due to how loud it was.
 - Little Samurai's traffic is down. Working on ideas to increase dinner crowd. Dining is helping to come up with ways to provide more variety and less expensive options (fried rice, veggies, soba noodles, etc).
- Wolfstore
 - Textbook sales are down.
 - Apparel sales are up
 - Social Media content is amazing. WOU students are helping with that and there have been many positive comments on it.
- Campus Dining
 - Press is open 2-7pm Mon-Fri. Opened 2 weeks ago. Grinder needs to be replaced and trained, so drink options are limited.
 - Caffè Allegro is open 830-2pm. Nutraslice online ordering is coming. Daxbot too for drinks.
 - Daxbot is going well. Working with Little Samurai to incorporate more. Information about Daxbot and Little Samurai's will be communicated more by Student Engagement and Campus Dining once that is received from Little Samurai's/
 - Catering is down with the budget restrictions currently in place.
 - Concerns were expressed by Campus Dining and others about the impact that online classes are having on traffic and people presence on the Monmouth

campus. This is something that will be mentioned again as having a big impact on budgets and the feel of campus.

- Campus Dining expressed concerns about student employees and not being able to get applications. Typically, 100 to 110 student employees and now at 70 or less. This is something seen in many areas across campus including the hiring fairs put on by the Center for Professional Pathways.

Old Business

- Vice Chair election was postponed given only 2 students on the call that are part of Student Engagement and a least one graduating Spring term.

New Business

- Chelsee will be sending out When is Goods for the Ad Hoc Committees that have people interested in joining. Chelsee will also be a part of those committees in order to have another person. Hope to have a couple meetings and can share thoughts at the April full WUC Advisory Committee meeting. If anyone wants to join another one, please let Chelsee know.

Next meeting in April

- This will be on Zoom. When is Good will come out in March to schedule a time.

Announcements

- Question was asked about IFC and Student Engagement Operations. We spoke about the IFC process and how the budget presentation was made last week. I share the 15%, 20% and 25% cut packages with the committee so they had that public information. The highlights we discussed were about the impact on student employment/professional staff and the WUC operating hours as well as maintenance budgets.
