  - At least a sophomore standing (45+ earned credits) by time of exchange

- A one-two page essay discussing your reasons for studying away, your goals while on exchange, and how you will meet your desired goals (Applicants are encouraged to visit the Writing Center prior to submitting essay)
- Interview with NSE Coordinator (Application will not be complete or processed without an interview)

- \$200.00 nonrefundable application fee (cover's processing fee and orientation)
- Application fee due at time of application submission

### **ACCOMODATIONS, SPECIAL NEEDS OR CIRCUMSTANCES**
