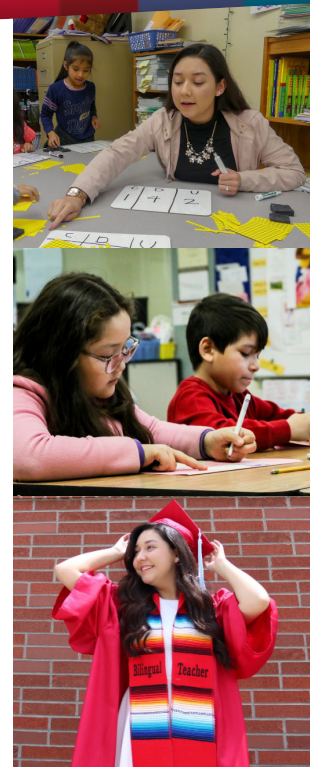


Bilingual Teacher Scholars Program

In collaboration with Oregon school districts and community colleges, Western Oregon University is seeking smart, energetic **bilingual** and **bicultural students** eager to join the next generation of Oregon teachers through the Bilingual Teacher Scholars Program!

The Bilingual Teacher Scholars Program aligns resources and opportunities

for students to attend Western Oregon University and **provides a scholarship up to \$3,000 per year**, renewable annually. Students in the program receive academic support, individualized advising and professional development opportunities. Upon completion, students may receive preferred hiring in their school districts.

YOU'RE ELIGIBLE IF YOU ARE:

- A **high school student** (*on track to graduate from an Oregon high school*)
- Bilingual in Spanish and English
- Admitted to Western Oregon University

YOU'RE ELIGIBLE IF YOU ARE:

- A **transfer student** from an Oregon community college
- Bilingual in Spanish and English
- Admitted to Western Oregon University

YOU'RE ELIGIBLE IF YOU ARE:

- An **incoming graduate student** entering either the Master of Arts in Teaching (Secondary Education), or the M.S. in Education (Special Education K-12), or the M.S. in Deaf and Hard of Hearing Education program.
- Bilingual in Spanish and English
- Admitted to Western Oregon University

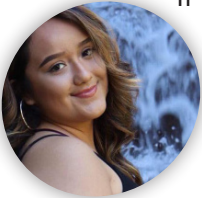
