Agenda Items

- I. Approval of January 2021 minutes
 - A. Approved (with minor edit of removing recording link since recordings aren't kept after minutes are approved)
- II. UCS/security update Cognos
 - A. Currently using Cognos version 10; it's really only fully functional when using Internet Explorer 11 (which is no longer supported by Microsoft as of November 2020)
 - B. IBM will stop supporting Cognos 10 in April 2021
 - C. Cognos 11 works in all browsers and has a new look and feel
 - D. Bill showed a Cognos 11 training video
- III. New business
 - A. LMS Policy Draft review
 - 1. Policy Council hasn't been meeting so this policy proposal has been on hold
 - 2. The current draft is a revision of the previous draft
 - 3. If UTAC approves, it will next go to Policy Council
 - 4. The most visible difference between the two drafts is a detailed chart being removed, which was a good move to not be too prescriptive in a policy (Chelle)
 - 5. Tried to enshrine the policies rather than the minutiae (Michael)

- 6. Amy and Michael talked through some differences between the original and new drafts
- 7. **ACTION**: Current draft of LMS Policy unanimously approved by UTAC; next step is to submit to Policy Council
- B. Discussion about whether UTAC is the place to spearhead technology and accessibility on campus (Stacey and Chelle)
 - 1. It might make sense to have a subcommittee about accessibility within UTAC (Stacey)
 - 2. This is an ongoing need and an important campus discussion (Stacey)
 - 3. Melanie has been participating in the OER and open access work and there's been discussion about accessibility and faculty have been expressing they appreciate learning more about accessibility; this is especially important with so much being online and remote
 - 4. A subcommittee could help direct people to resources and professional development; there's also advisory capacity to the president, if UTAC were to identify something policy related that needed action (Chelle)
 - 5. The timing is good with the Canvas conversion and people are looking to set themselves up for success long-term while they're setting up courses in Canvas (Michael)
 - We've planned proactively for culturally responsible pedagogy, but reactively for accessibility and there's a desire from people to shift to more proactive accessibility planning instead of waiting to be notified by a student that they need accomodation (Melanie)
 - 7. Chelle will work with Stacey, Michael and Lisa to develop an agenda item for next month
