New Agenda items

- Banner 9 Self Service and Ellucian Experience Premium Kolis
 - Ellucian Experience is a gateway to everything Portal like
 - Has a main menu with cards
 - Allows for lots of searchable content
 - Actionable campus information with real-time updates
 - Open to deliver Ellucian or non-ellucian applications
 - Cards can be quickly and easily created with existing content
 - Premium will provide a mobile application with more branding
 - Premium allows Applications to be shared using "pages"
 - Eastern ORegon University has adopted this as their portal
 - Need a structure for how content is managed could use a subcommittee
 - WolfWeb is going away moving to Employee Self Service version 9
 - Only available to unclassified today for web timesheets
 - Rolling out next year for everyone

- Ellucian Go deprecation decision
 - Kolis is going to get usage numbers to UTAC
 - Discuss offline if and when the old app will go away
 - Ellucian is going to stop supporting it
 - Should UTAC decide when to stop putting resources into it?
 - We just got it back in the app store.
- Might not be enough for the mobile app for students for accessibility
 - Future topic for UTAC _
- Navigate expansion Paige Jackson
 - Improve advising and clarity
 - Centralized communication plan for students from multiple modes
 - Get metrics and IR data e.g chairs can view
 - More data available
 - Navigate is an existing tool -
 - used to schedule professional meetings
 - Early alerts to individual students
 - Can implement new modules using grant money
 - Mobile app app that is only student facing (also desktop)
 - Schedule appointments, intake survey, communications
 - Resolve holds, register for classes, raise a hand to advising
 - Can push notifications.
 - Historical analytics module is the first new module to implement
 - Proactive advising for those who need support based on data
 - Course data will be made available in the new modules
 - Branded NAvigate and then the student selects the school.
 - UofO uses this app. Orientation had a separate app that made it confusing.
 - HandShake is used for student employment Can clicks in the app take students to HandShake?
 - Career readiness assessment? Can this be inside Navigate? Intake survey could have additional questions. Could also do surveys.
- Should look at Navigate and Experience together to determine what is the best student experience. Experience might be for a different audience, like staff. Need one WOU app.

 - Amy/Chelle Debrief Academic Council Discussion; was not discussed in the meeting. Will follow up with the college deans with the Astra data.
 - Camila Ad Astra Data; some labs have not had reservations in the last 1.5
 years. Some uptick in use of labs, some are still not used (like ITC). Camila will
