- There are 56 planned projects UCS will work on. Remainder on hold for various reasons (aspirational but not necessary, etc..).
- Have a timeline chart to identify when projects are scheduled to start and how long in days it is planned to take.
- For UTAC Tom has aligned projects to the themes shared with UTAC and made them a bit easier to read for us.
- o UTAC uses this to know what is being worked on. What our resources allow.
- Need a consistent strategic way to request/add/prioritize new projects/requests.
 New technology requests are part of UTAC's charge. How do we build that out and incorporate it with UCS's planning. One option is through a UCS ticketing system. Ticket is submitted to create and that comes to UTAC.
- The spreadsheet is a high level representation of the work.
- We need to coordinate with individuals to coordinate what work needs to be done and when. There is a need to coordinate effectively with users to incorporate testing and other project work in a way that accounts for their daily work and unit projects not represented in this list.

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- how to implement and roll out Experience as a WolfWeb sequel.
- Select workshop dates and attendees
- Experience premium will be the new interface to Wolf Web. WOU has to move to the new version of self-service. Current attempts to use the baseline product haven't worked. We are investing in premium and these workshops will help us learn how to use it.
- Premium may replace the portal which is how campus access almost all technology. UTAC can help in this roll out so it is helpful for UTAC members to attend the training if possible.
- Kolis will send another meeting and share what time commitment information he has.
- Student Mobile Environment Subcommittee (Tom)
 - Experience premium will replace myWOU. Should we use the Ellucian tool?
 - Reviewed the charge for a potential new UTAC subcommittee for mobile environments.
 - We will form the subcommittee. Camila is on the subcommittee. Amy will find someone from Registrar. Encouraged others to volunteer or go back to their
